BETWEEN

THE UNIVERSITY OF WINNIPEG FACULTY ASSOCIATION
(MAIN UNIT: MLB-6362) (the UWFA)

RE: Search Process – Coordinator of, Masters in Development Practice Program (MDP)

WHEREAS the Senate has newly approved the Masters in Development Practice Program; and


WHEREAS the funding for the MDPP includes a Coordinator position for which a search is necessary; and

THEREFORE the Parties agree to the following when recruiting to the Co-ordinator position:


1. To abide by the general principles of Clause 22.04 of the Collective Agreement; and
2. The Dean of Business and Economics shall establish a Search Committee which shall make its recommendation both for the position and an appropriate academic appointment, to the Vice-President Academic and ultimately to the President ; and
3. The Search Committee shall be composed as follows:
 - a) Five (5) Members, one (1) each of whom shall be chosen from the Aboriginal Governance Program, the Departments of Economics, Geography, and Sociology, and from the Faculty of Education; and
 - b) Two (2) of the Search Committee members shall be the Chair of their Departments; and
 - c) The Dean of Business and Economics will sit as the non-voting chair of the Committee and select the Committee members (described in b)); and
 - d) In the event that a Member resigns from the committee the Dean shall replace him or her with a Member from a Program, Department, or Faculty named in (a); and
 - e) The Dean shall be responsible for consulting the appropriate DPC and obtaining that DPC's agreement to the academic appointment of the Co-ordinator, to that Department.
